TIGERS TAKE THIRD AT BIG WEST CHAMPIONSHIP



Rancho Santa Margarita, California - Senior Thomas Petersson finished in fourth place in his last college tournament and only fittingly he led Pacific once again, this time to a third place finish in the Big West Championship. Behind consistent golf throughout the week the Tigers shot rounds of 292, 292 and 287 at the conference tournament.

Petersson carded a final round 70 at the 6,918-yard Tijeras Creek Golf Club, finishing with a 54-hole score of 213. Junior Chris Rosenau shot a 217 and A.J. Hohn posted a final-round even par to end at 219. Freshman Bayhaan Lakdawala carded a final-round 70, the lowest round of his career, while sophomore Charlie Van Sicklen entered the clubhouse at 232.

"This is a great finish for this program. To come into the Big West Championship, shoot under-par in the final round and finish third overall is something I'm extremely happy about," said head coach Brandon Goethals. "This team has come a long way in two years. I'm also very proud of Thomas for ending his career at Pacific on a high note with a fourth place finish. I really look forward to next season."

UC Irvine took the team title, shooting -12 over the two day tournament and Cal Poly closed close on their heels with a -9 showing. Individually Long Beach State's Brett Lederer finished with a 204, -12.

PETERSSON NAMED FIRST TEAM ALL BIG WEST

Stockton, California - Senior Thomas Petersson was named to the Big West All-Conference First Team for his play during the 2006-07 season. Petersson led the Tigers throughout the season, leading the team with a 73.0 stroke average over 12 tournaments.

Petersson, an honorable mention selection last season posted rounds of 74-69-70=213 at the Big West Championships this past week, leading the Tigers to a third place finish. He finishes his final year at Pacific with 14 rounds under par this season and six rounds in the 60's.

"I'm extremely proud to be selected to the First Team," said Petersson. "It's great to see that the work I've put in has paid off for myself and the team. It's a great indication that I have been and continue to do the right things."

Thomas has been a mainstay at the number one position for the Tigers over the past two seasons. In his four years as a Tigers Thomas accumulated a stroke average of 74.6 over 121 rounds. "I had four great years at Pacific and it has been wonderful to have the opportunity to play highly competitive college golf," said Petersson. "I have had invaluable experiences and I look forward to take on new challenges both on the golf course and in the business world."

Petersson placed in the top 10 in five tournaments this season, his lowest finish being a third place showing at the Rice Intercollegiate in February. He posted a career-low 66 at the UH-Hilo Intercollegiate in the Tigers' first tournament of the spring season.

"Thomas has been a wonderful player and leader for us for the past four years," said head coach Brandon Goethals. "He exemplified this program and the things we try to do. I'm proud of him and all he has accomplished."

With the Pacific Invitational turning into a premier event and impact players entering the lineup Goethals has the Tigers on the right path to national prominence.

Last season, Goethals' first as head coach at Pacific, the Tigers claimed seven Top 10 finishes. The team also had twelve individual rounds under par and 16 Top 25 individual finishes. Under Goethals' tutelage the Tigers completed a successful fall season, as they finished ninth at the Lexus Classic and the Santa Clara Invitational and placed fourth at the Bill Cullum Intercollegiate.

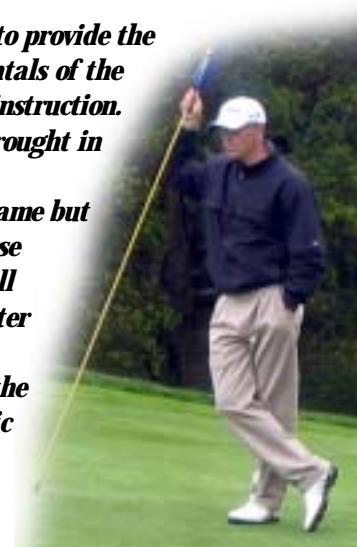
