### TIGERS TAKE EIGHTH AT FRESNO LEXUS CLASSIC

March 13, 2007

**Fresno, California** - A third straight round of 71 gave senior Thomas Petersson a fourth place finish at the Fresno Lexus Classic, Tuesday, March 13. His three-under par was instrumental in guiding the Pacific Golf team to an eighth place overall finish.

The Tigers' posted a 54-hole score of 298-296-292=886 to tie for eighth place overall with New Mexico State. Petersson's 213 for the two-day event was his fourth Top-10 finish of the 2006-07 season; he finished just four strokes back from the individual champion, Brian Edick of UC Irvine.

Junior Chris Rosenau finished second for the Tigers, posting a final round 74 at the 6,946-yard course. He shot a 223 for the tournament while fellow junior A.J. Hohn placed 56th with a 229. Freshman Patrick Kucich carded a final round 78 for an overall 231 and Bayhaan Lakdawala recorded a 77 for a 54-hole score of 233.

"Thomas once again placed stellar golf and did the things he needed to do to keep himself in the hunt," said coach Brandon Goethals. "We improved each round throughout the week and that's a testament to the guys grinding it out and working hard through the finish."

San Diego State took home the team title with a 15-under, 849 while UC Irvine placed second, shooting an 850.

### PACIFIC GOLF 15TH AT WESTERN INTERCOLLEGIATE

March 20, 2007

**Santa Cruz, California** - The Pacific golf team finished in 15th place at the Western Intercollegiate, Tuesday, March 20th, shooting a final round 298 at Pasatiempo Golf Course. The Tigers were led by junior A.J. Hohn's 54-hole score of 221.

Pacific battled back from 17th place after scores of 302 and 299 during day one of the 61st Western Intercollegiate. Hohn led the Tigers individually, placing 39th place after shooting a two-day score of 221.

Senior Thomas Petersson and junior Chris Rosenau finished in 55th place, posting rounds of 74-77-75 and 77-73-76 respectively. Freshman Bayhaan Lakdawala and Patrick Kucich shot scores of 229 and 235 at the 6,432-yard, par 70 course.

"There's not a lot to be happy about after this performance," said coach Brandon Goethals. "However, it's only a failure if we fail to learn from what we did in this tournament. We will learn from this as we always do in everything we do."

Purdue University took the team title, shooting rounds of 279-283-287. John Streibich of Xavier took the individual title, posting scores of 67-69-63=199 to finish the tournament at 11-under.

### TIGERS BACK IN OREGON FOR DUCK INVITATIONAL

The Pacific golf team travels to Eugene, Oregon this weekend for the Oregon Duck Invitational at Eugene Country Club. The tournament begins Monday morning at 8:00 am with 36-holes at the 7,033-yard, par 72 course. The final 18-holes will take place Tuesday morning, March 27th.

The mainly Pac-10 field features three of the nation's top 10 teams according to the latest Golfweek rankings. The Tigers will be paired with #1 Stanford and #6 USC during the first day of the tournament. Also in the field is #9 UCLA, #21 Arizona State and #28 Arizona.

Last season the Tigers took ninth place at the Duck Invitational, held at Shadow Hills Country Club. Pacific shot a 294-309-304 for 54-holes with then sophomore Chris Rosenau firing a 221 for 27th place.

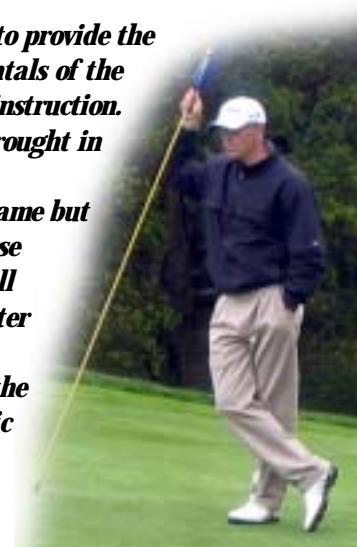
